NSW IMOS Node

- The revised NSW-IMOS **Science and Implementation Plan** has been completed and submitted to IMOS. Gary Meyers has made especially positive comments after reviewing the plan
- IMOS has issued template reports for Nodes and Facilities to start work on for the upcoming midterm review.

NSW Moorings

- NSW Moorings has now moved to order the equipment for the deployment of the Coffs Harbour moorings.
- Still awaiting reports from the instrument supplier regards the failure of 3 of the 4 ADCP's purchased by SIMS. Sending all 4 back to manufacturer.

- All captive bred Wobbegongs have been tagged at the Sydney Aquarium.
